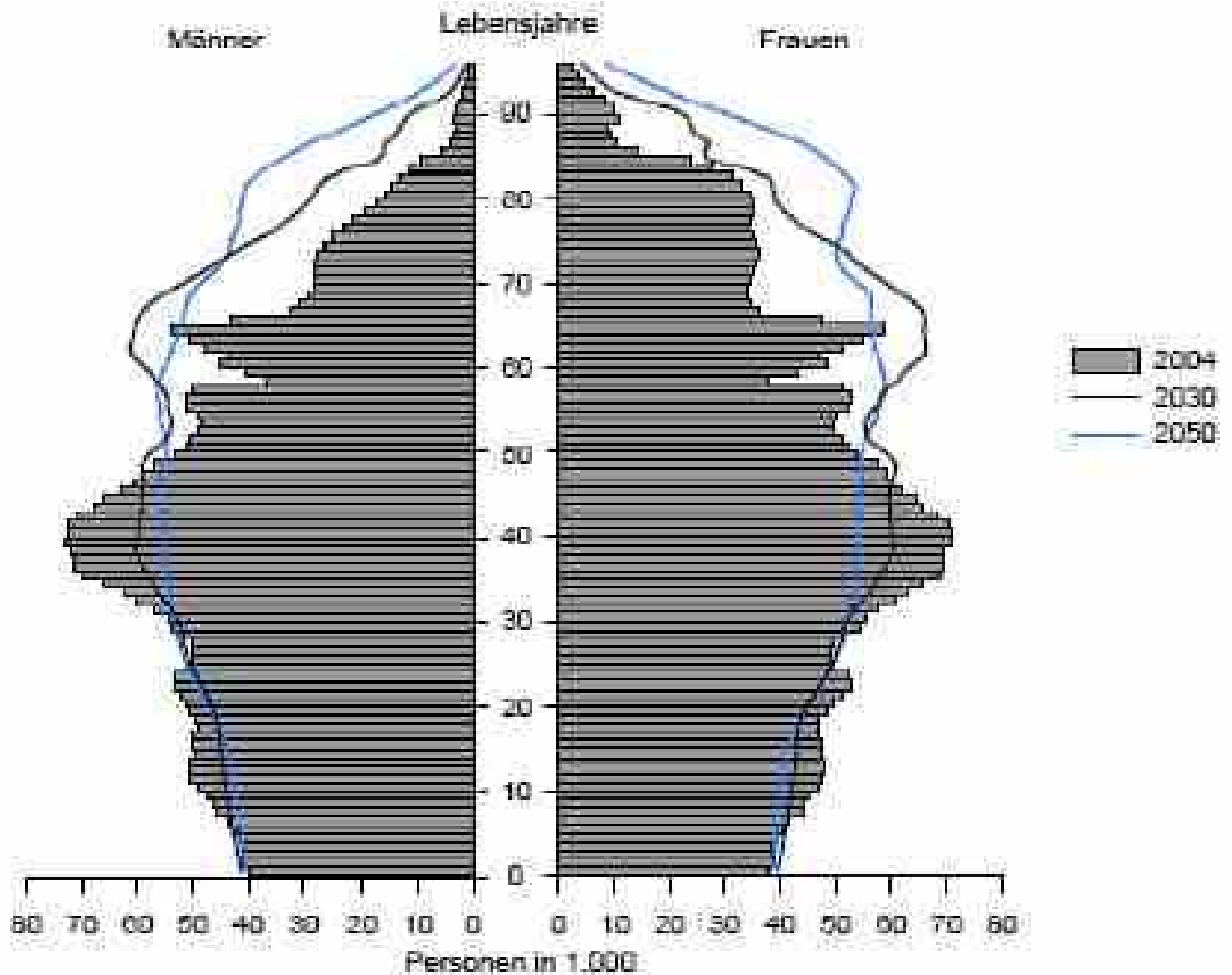

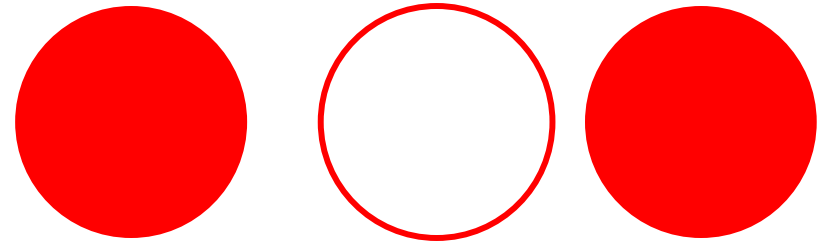
Bevölkerungspyramide 2004, 2030 und 2050







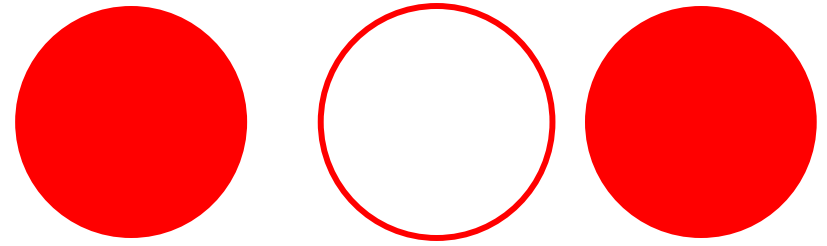
Family Situation

Kindergarten

- Differences don't affect their choice of friends



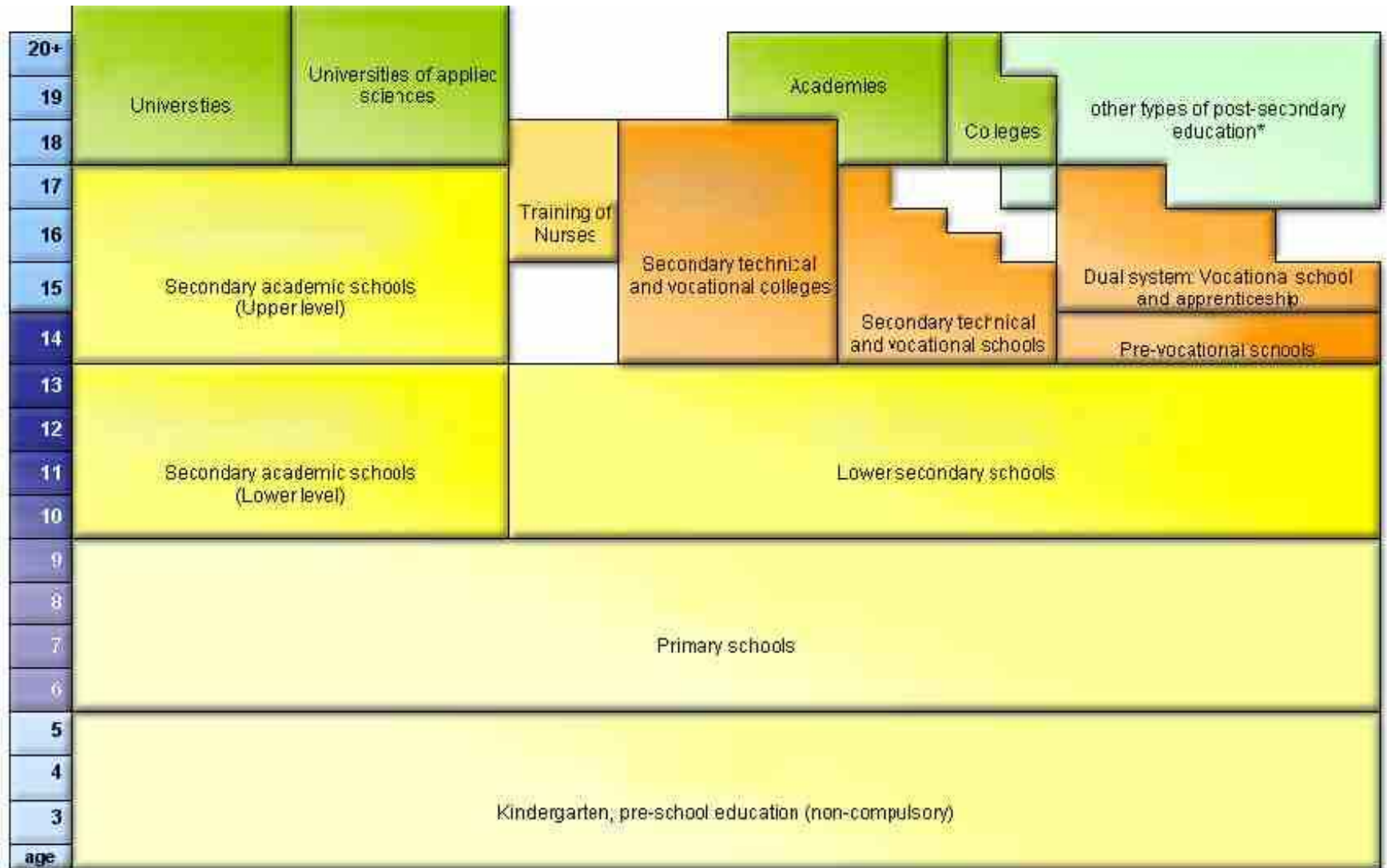
Split up with 10 years

- in which social situation the child grows up

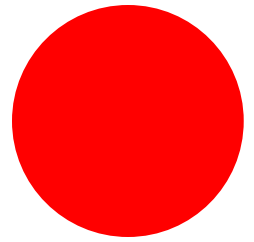
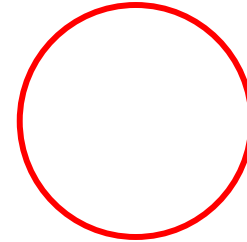
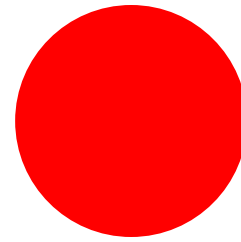

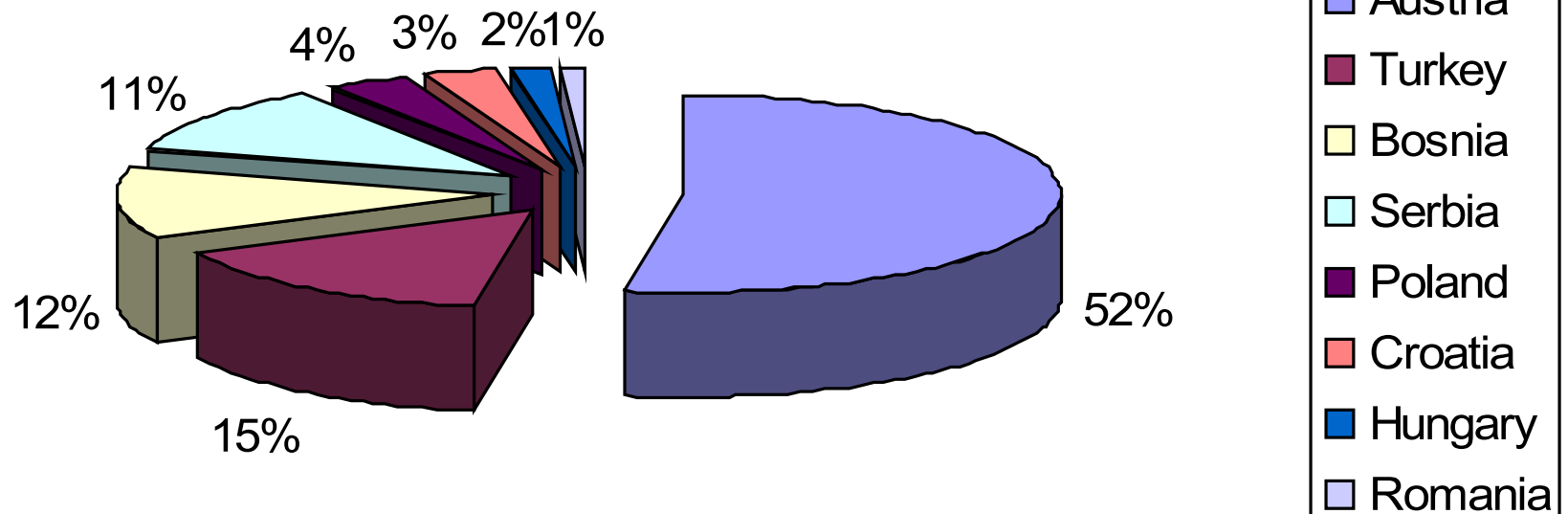

Unemployment

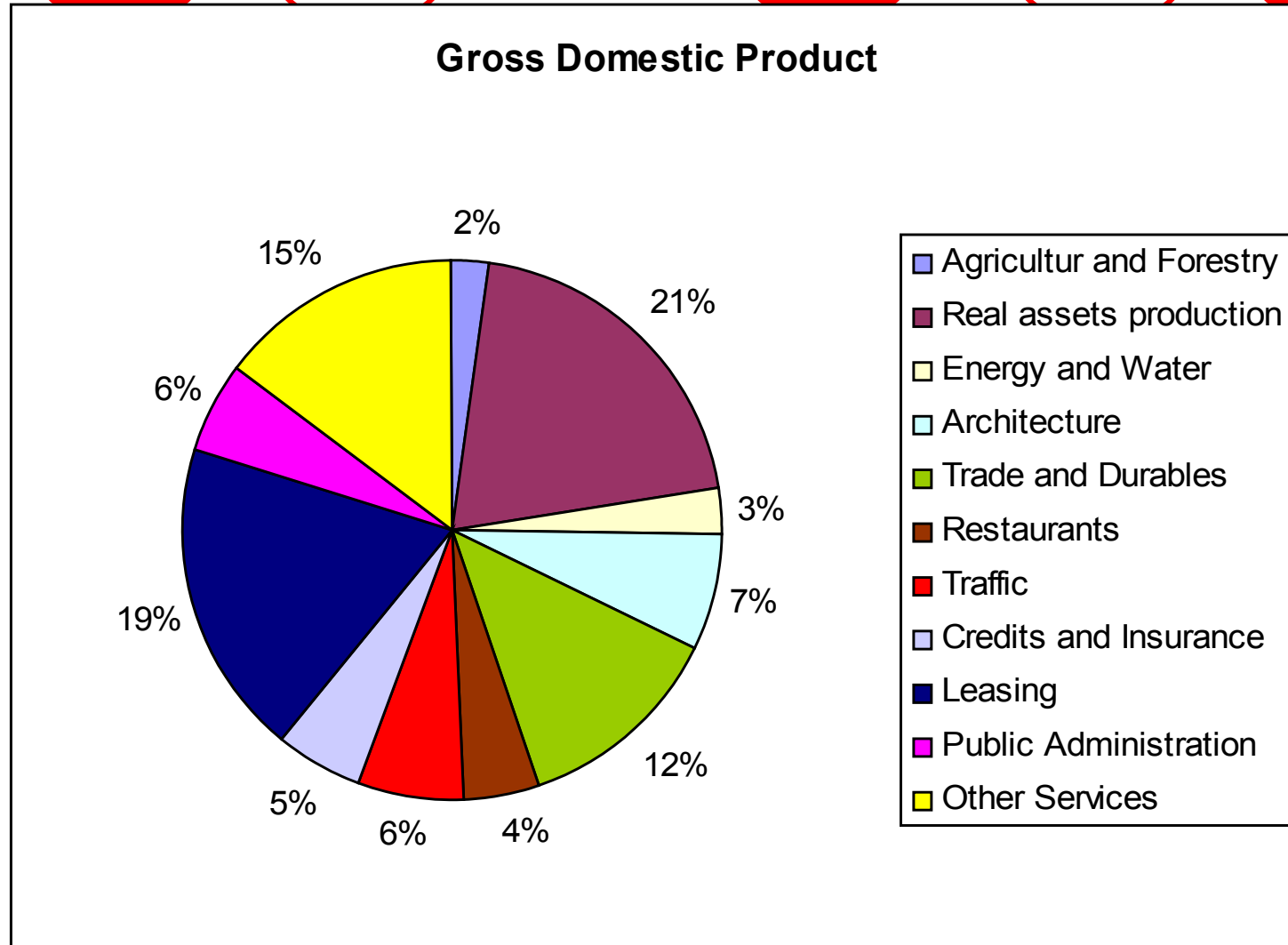


- Men 3,90 %

- Long-term unemployed 20,0 %



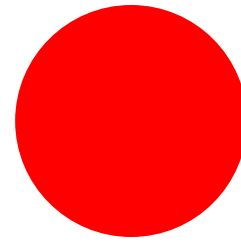

Gross Domestic Product

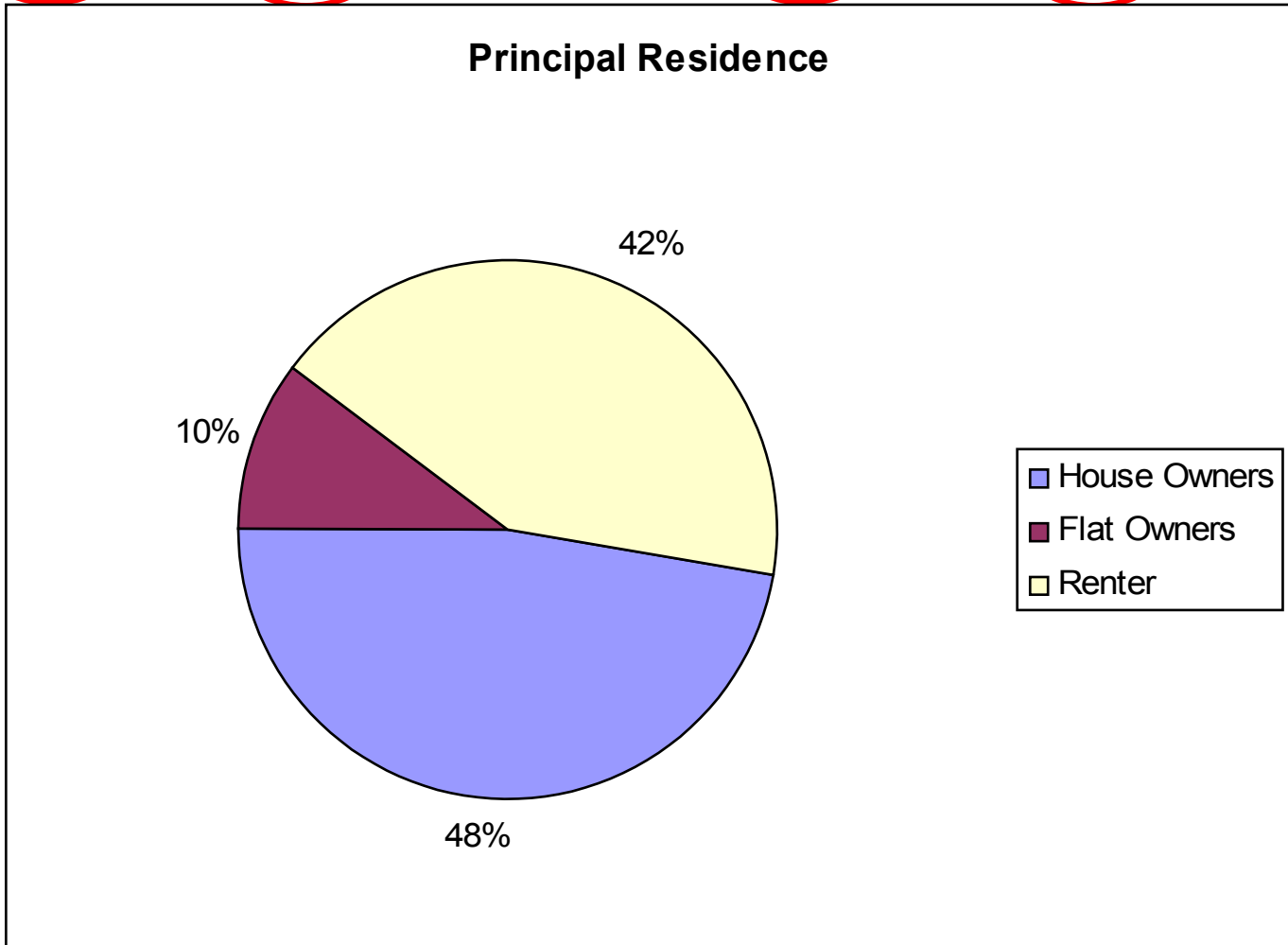

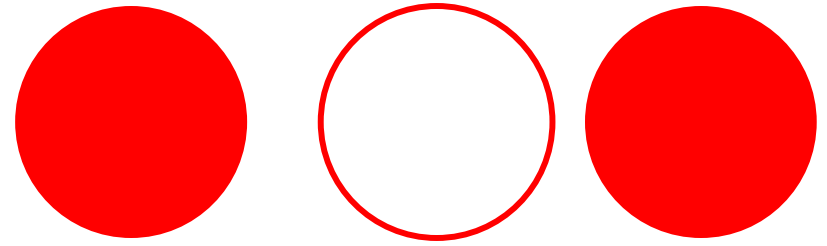
